

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

- Council held a regular meeting March 14th/17.
- Permission was granted to Women in Business to use Lot 11, Block 5, Plan S6147 for a Farmers' Market for the coming summer.
- Samantha Herring was hired as the Recreation Office Liaison.
- Council accepted the Ministry of Highways and Infrastructure's offer to fund 16% of the \$1.3 million investment for storm water drainage less a calculated cost of \$57,000 in order to accommodate our request for the new service road on the east side of Delisle to have a 10 m. finished top and have an additional subgrade width to accommodate a 1.5 m. sidewalk and curb/gutter.
- Vincent Nelson's bid of \$60/acre/year to lease and farm NE & SE 19-34-8-W3 for the next two years was accepted.
- Retroactive to January 1st, 2017, the mayor shall receive council remuneration of \$600/month and each councillor shall receive remuneration of \$400/month.
