



# **Council Highlights**

- Council held a regular meeting on Tuesday, November 13th.
- The Town entered into a retainer agreement with the law firm Miller Thomson for the purpose of preparing documentation and acting as the Town's prosecutor at the Kindersley Bylaw court.
- The Town entered into a 2019 Road Maintenance Agreement with the Ministry of Highways for the most westerly 150 meters of Elevator Road.
- The Town renewed its stockpile site lease at the new east Highway 7 access for another year with Russell Redi-Mix Concrete.
- The Town supports, in principle, the construction of a splash park in Delisle with the Town willing to donate Lot 4, Block 31 (by the new ball diamonds) as the preferred location. The Town is willing to assume the operation and maintenance of the facility providing the Town is not responsible for the capital cost of the project.
- An AED will be purchased for the Town Hall.
- Various overdue accounts (fire response, water & sewer, waste collection) will be added to the taxes of the property that they were provided to if they remain unpaid as of December 31st, 2018.
