Criminal Record Checks – if you require a Criminal Record check for employment or volunteering, there are a few things you need to know. **You must appear in person with 2 pieces of valid government issued identification i.e. driver's license, health card, passport. Also, you must reside within the policing jurisdiction.**

Golf carts are not meant to be used as a general means of transportation within Town limits. These rules must be strictly followed or this privilege may be revoked.

- Council held a special meeting April 30th, 2018 and a regular meeting on May 8th.
- The municipal tax mill rate and base taxes remain unchanged for 2018. The municipal rate is 3.6 mills. The school tax mill rates remain the same for 2018 as well.
- The 2018 municipal budget was approved with an anticipated budgeted surplus of \$467.00.
- Council approved the proposed subdivision of Parcel K in NE 13-34-9-W3. This is the site where the new Town well is being developed.
