

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

- Council held a regular meeting October 10th, 2017.
- The Town accepted the bid of \$381,921.00, taxes included, submitted by DC Trenching Ltd. for the supply and installation of raw water lines in connection with the development of two new wells.
- The Town of Delisle has hired Mr. Bob McCrea as the new Bylaw Enforcement Officer. Mr. McCrea can be contacted directly at 306-321-2617.
- The Delisle Citizens on Patrol program and committee were officially recognized as an extension of the Town of Delisle's Police Commission.
- The VMAD District Emergency Planning Committee was officially recognized as the Town of Delisle's Emergency Measures Organization regarding emergency planning. Appointed to this committee was Dan Crapley and Mark Dubkowski with Dave Anderchek as an alternate representative.

WATER RATES:

Starting August 15/17 - Excess water consumption rates will increase to \$10.00/1,000 gallons. The current excess water rate is \$8.00/1,000 gallons. The excess rate increase reflects an user pay philosophy that users who consume more shall pay a proportionately larger share of the costs. The changes will be noticed on the November, 2017 quarterly billing.

COMPOST PICK-UP

Compost will be picked up on Tues., November 7th & 21st, weather permitting. Compost will be picked up in the back alley and should be in a 17 gallon capacity plastic or metal can. Garden waste will be collected during compost pickup without any need to package the garden waste. The town will collect garden waste provided it is in a convenient area in the back alley. Grass clippings and leaves must still be in an open container or bin that can be easily dumped.
