COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

- Council held a regular meeting on October 13th.
- Council passed a motion approving the proposed subdivision of the new Highway Commercial lots along the east end of Railway Avenue. The surveyors will now begin the consultation process for this subdivision.
- No tenders were received for the purchase of Lot 10, Block 5, Plan S6147. The property will now be listed for sale in "as is" condition for \$30,000 plus GST.
- The Arena Covid-19 Protocol was amended to reflect changes brought forward by the Sask. Hockey Association. The Protocol can be found on the Town website.
- Three outstanding accounts will be added to taxes if they remain unpaid as of December 31, 2020.
- The fee to lodge an Assessment Appeal has now increased from \$25 to \$100 per appeal.
- A big thank you and a nod of gratitude to Mayor Dave Anderchek and Councillor Dan Mantyka for all their work on Town Council. Both individuals chose not to seek re-election.
