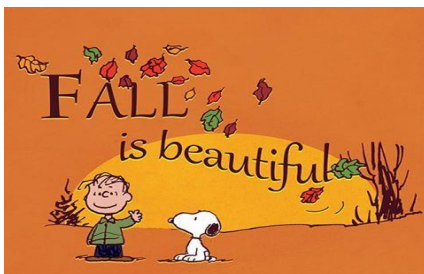

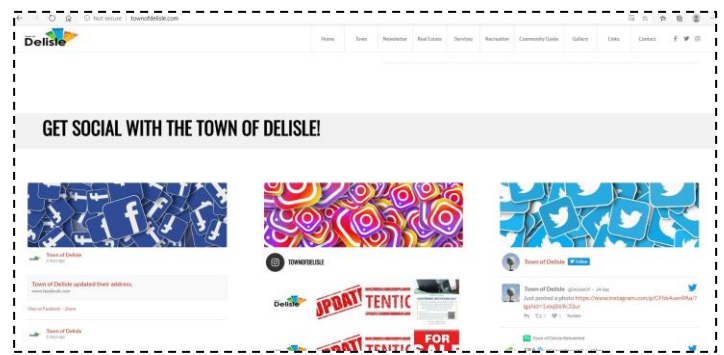

COMPOST & GARDEN WASTE

Pick-up will be Oct. 6th & Oct. 20th. **WEATHER PERMITTING.** Compost will be picked up in the back alley and should be in a 17-gallon capacity plastic or metal can. Garden waste will be collected during compost pickup without any need to package. The town will collect garden waste provided it is in a convenient area in the back alley. Grass clippings must still be in an open container or bin that can be easily dumped.

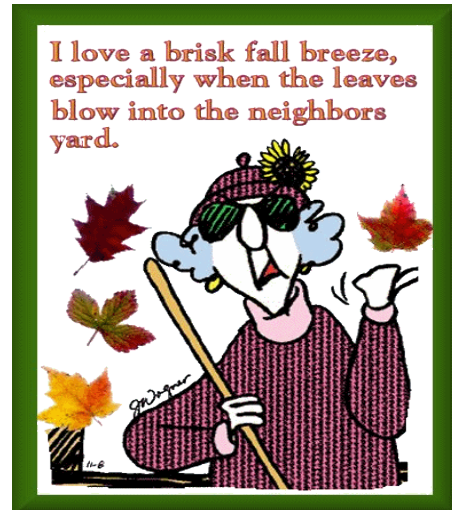
