

## CONSTRUCTION

Beginning August 30<sup>th</sup>, Lafarge Canada will begin installing a storm drain at the Main Street/5<sup>th</sup> Avenue East intersection. Pick-up will be Sept. 7<sup>th</sup> for COMPOST & Sept. 21<sup>st</sup> for COMPOST & GARDEN WASTE.  
Garden waste will be collected during compost pickup without any need to package the garden waste. The Town will collect garden waste provided it is in a convenient area in the back alley. This service is only for garden waste and only available on Sept. 21<sup>st</sup>.  
Compost will be picked up in the back alley and should be in a 17-gallon capacity plastic or metal can. If weather conditions are not favorable, pick-up will occur later in the week.

### ANNUAL WATERWORKS REPORT

The following is information on the Town of Delisle's waterworks, as required under The Municipalities Regulations.

2020 Waterworks Financial Overview  
Total water & sewer revenue - \$351,984  
Total water & sewer expenses - \$344,355  
Total debt payments – NIL  
Comparison of revenues to expenses plus debt payments expressed as a ratio –  
 $\$351,984 / \$344,355 + \text{NIL} = 1.02$   
For 2020, water and sewer revenues covered 102% of water and sewer expenditures. This is a small decrease from last year.

Council held a regular meeting on August 10<sup>th</sup>.

The Town approved the temporary street closure of 2<sup>nd</sup> Street East in front of the schools including 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Sept. 11<sup>th</sup> for the hosting of an Emergency Responders Fun Day put on by the local fire department.


R3 Construction's quote of \$18,482.00 plus taxes for the provision of a cement slab floor for the Splash Park storage building was accepted.
