

Town of Delisle Snow Removal Policy

(Mar. 8, 2022)

Priority Streets (Grader)

- 1 – Driving lanes of Railway Ave./Service Road
- 2 – Access to school driving lanes
 - 3rd St. E./4th Ave./2nd St. E
- 3 – Driving lanes of 3rd Ave./3rd St. W.
- 4 – Driving lanes of 1st St. W., Valleyview Access to North End (Bentley Ave, Fairway Dr.)
- 5 – Driving lanes of Main St. to 6th Ave. East/West, 2nd Ave to 4th St. W. access
- 6 – Driving lanes of all other streets including cul-de-sacs as needed
- 7 – South Industrial Roads
- 8 – Parking lanes in order of above or as vehicles move off of lanes
 - Snow removal may occur as needed by build-up levels

Priority for Loader

- 1 – Fire Hall access in front of doors
- 2 – Intersection of Main St./6th Ave. W. if completely blocked (worst intersection in town)
- 3 – Early Learning Center parking lot
- 4 – Any intersection completely blocked
- 5 – Town Office/RCMP front & back
 - snow pushed to front
- 6 – Town Hall front/back/sides if playschool day
 - snow piled in back
- 7 – Water Treatment Plant & Transfer Station (if open)
- 8 – Rink lot/doors
- 9 – Business alleys
- 10 – General alleys
- 11 - Cemetery

Patrol Blading/Ridging Policy

- When ridging snow to the center of streets, a crossing or driving gap will be created approximately every 50 feet or as needed so citizens do not need to climb over ridges.
- Railway Ave./Service Road
 - Cleared to shoulder
- 3rd St. E./4th Ave./3rd Ave.
 - Cleared to shoulder
- School (2nd St. E.) – Ridged to center
 - 300 Block 2nd St. E. to shoulder
- 3rd St. W. (100 – 400 Block) – to shoulder
 - 500 – 700 Blk to center – dragged if time
- Main St. – Ridged to center except 400 Block to edge
- 1st St. W. – Ridged to center
- 1st St. E. – Ridged to Center – dragged if time
- 6th Ave./5th Ave. Ridged to center - dragged if time
- Valleyview Drive, Bentley Ave., Fairway Dr. to shoulder
- 2nd St. W. – 100 Block to center
 - 200 -300 Block to shoulder
- 1st Ave., 2nd Ave., 4th St. W., Edward, 3A St. – Shoulder
- Worth Dr. – Dragged/pushed to ball diamonds

Blizzard/Cold Weather Conditions

- If a major storm and/or extreme wind gusts exists and no visibility puts workers at risk, then no equipment shall operate until storm recedes or foreman is certain that no safety hazards exist.
- No equipment will be used when temperature is minus 40 degrees with or without windchill or at the foreman's discretion.

Daily Inspections

- Foreman's discretion if snow removal is done on weekends, holidays, etc.
- Sanding of intersections will be done first followed by streets if freezing rain exists
- Parking lots get sanded as required
