COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

Town Council held a regular meeting on May 10th.

Northern Blacktop will be hired to apply a 35 mm. layer of asphalt at the Railway Avenue/1st Street West intersection as well as a 20 mm. layer of asphalt on Railway Avenue from 1st Street West to 3rd Avenue for a total estimated cost of \$86,000 plus taxes.

The Town supports the Rodeo Committee's proposal to make improvements to the old concession building located at the Rodeo grounds south of Elevator Road and the Town will contribute \$2,100 for electrical improvements to the building.

The Town granted permission to Carole Gallagher for the establishment of a recurring Farmers' Market at 223 – 1st Street West.

Permission was also granted for the temporary closure of 1st Street West on Saturday, July 9th in order to accommodate the annual Show and Shine.
