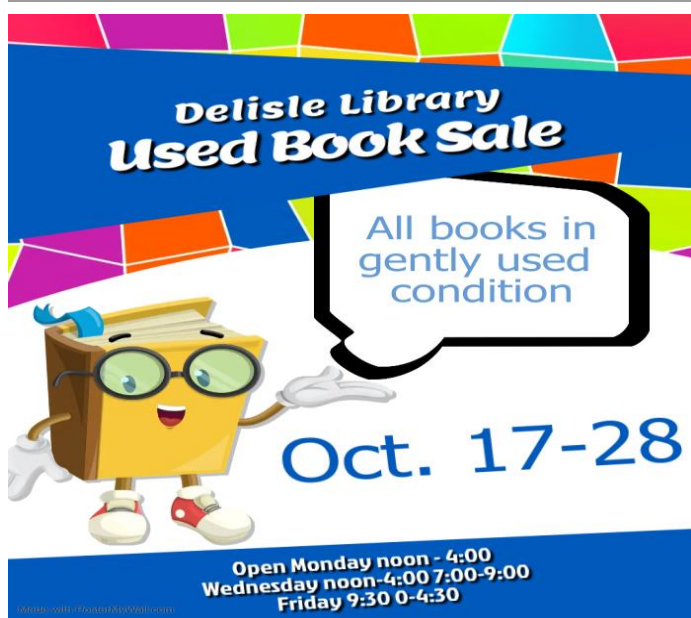
DELISLE EARLY LEARNING CENTER

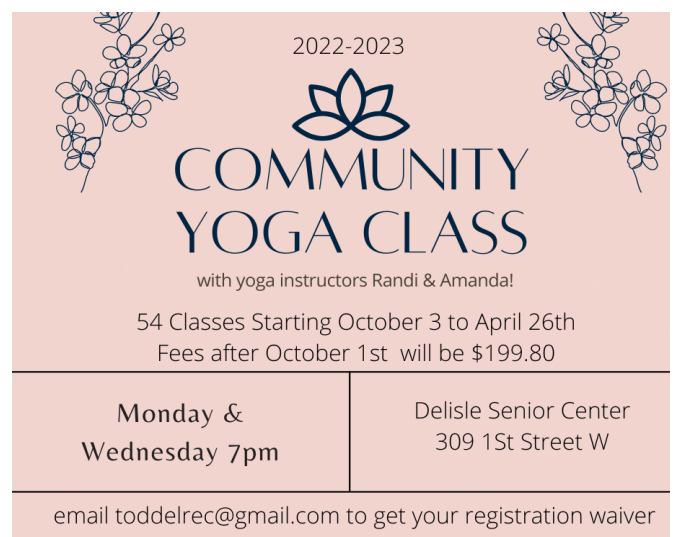
HALL CARETAKING CONTRACT
