<p>COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS</p> <p>Council held a regular meeting on December 13th.</p> <p>A letter will be sent to the Minister of Government Relations with a copy sent to SUMA requesting a change in the date set by the province for the holding of urban municipal elections. Currently, the next urban municipal general election date is slated for November 13, 2024.
