

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

Council held a regular meeting on February 14th.

The Town authorized the purchase of a 2023 snow push attachment for the bucket of the New Holland tractor.

Councillor Ryan King tendered his resignation from Town Council effective March 17, 2023. A byelection will be held May 31, 2023 to fill this upcoming vacancy on Town Council.

A letter will be written to various provincial government and opposition dignitaries insisting on the provincial government obtaining the services of a Family Physician or a second Nurse Practitioner at the Delisle Primary Health Centre.

\$20,550 from the 2022 water and sewer utility operation will be set aside in the Town's credit union savings account earmarked for the replacement of the sewage lift station on the east side of town.

In anticipation of the eventual replacement of this lift station, Council instructed the administrator to prepare a bylaw to increase sewer rates. It is proposed that residential sewer rates will increase by \$5/month.

A revised Arena Ice Rental, Payment and Cancellation Policy was adopted.

The Town will apply for funding under the Green & Inclusive Community Buildings program for replacement of the arena ice plant and the ice surface area lighting in the curling rink.

Council authorized the initiation of tax enforcement proceedings against Lots 15 & 21, Block 3, Plan S6147.

The regular meeting for the month of August, 2023 will now be held on August 15th at the Town Office commencing at 7:00 p.m.


