### COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

Town Council held a regular meeting on March 14, 2023.

Council authorized the initiation of tax enforcement proceedings against Lots 16 & 17, Block 12, Plan G11.

Council passed a bylaw that will see residential sewer rates increase by \$5/month. This rate increase will not show up on water & sewer invoices until the August mail out.

Over the years the center was supported by families from this R.M. In 2020, the Delisle Center opened, and now the Asquith Center is scheduled to open in 2023. Recently, the VELC opened in Asquith and Pike Lake before and after school programs at the local schools. Day camps for school age children are available during some school breaks and summer.
