COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

Council held a regular meeting on April 11th.

The Delisle Pride U23 Fastball Club was granted permission to hold an outdoor liquor function at Harold Worth Park (ball diamonds) from June 2nd to 4th.

The arena booth kitchen lease with Lowell Epp was renewed for the 2023-24 season on the same terms and conditions presently in effect.

Plainsman HVAC-R Ltd. was hired to supply and install a new furnace for the arena lobby.

The 2023 budget was approved at the April 26th special meeting. The municipal mill rate will increase by .1 mills to 3.8 mills primarily due to inflationary cost increases. The municipal base tax and the school tax rates will remain the same for 2023.

Two candidates, (*Mitch Obrigewitsch and Nicolaas Vandenameele*), have let their names stand to fill the one vacant seat on Town Council. See the accompanying notices for when Town residents can come out and vote for their choice.

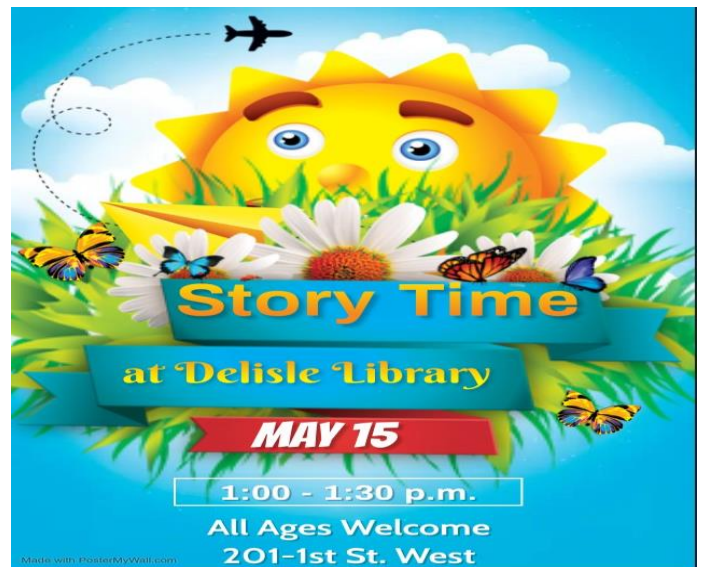
