For the remainder of the week, the Town will be exercising water valves. This should have very little effect on water quality.

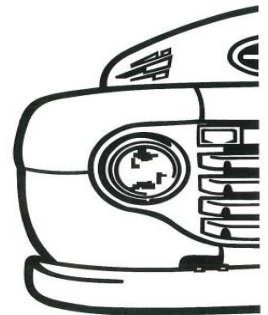

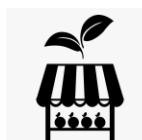

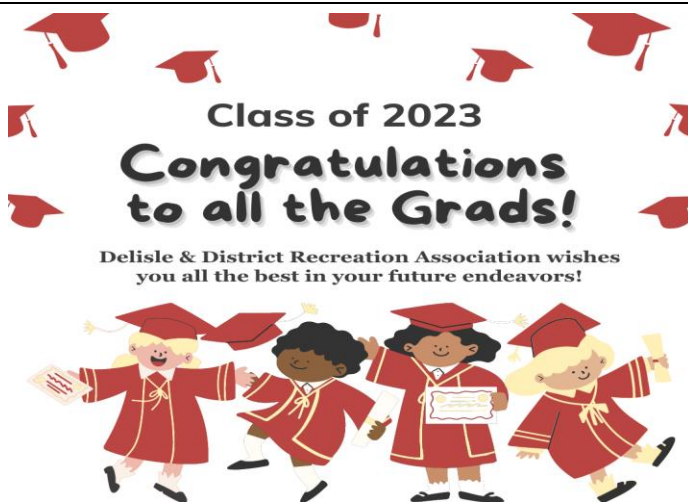


Harold Worth Park
