We are looking to grow our EA sub list. If you enjoy working with students we would love to have you in our school. Sub EA hours are 8:45 - 3:15.

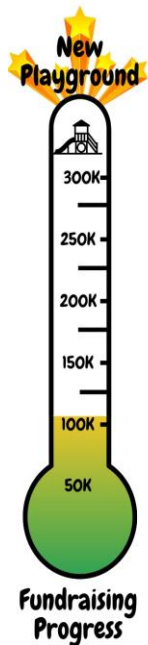
