Council had a regular meeting on January 9th during which the following items were addressed:

Council supported a new snow clearing policy.

A resolution was made to remove the lane separation sign located on 5th avenue and 3A Street East.

Bylaw 9-2024; being a bylaw amending the nuisance bylaw, was passed requiring property owners with adjoining sidewalks to clear their sidewalks of snow, ice, dirt, and debris within 24 hours of such being deposited thereon.

Bylaw 1-2025; being a new Council Procedures Bylaw, was passed.

Council had a special meeting on January 21st. A resolution was made accepting the Town Insurance Policy and Employees' Fidelity Bond and authorizing payment of the premium in the amount of \$77, 598.36 (includes PST).
