Council had a regular meeting on March 13th.

Councillor Cary Brunett was appointed as an alternate committee member for the Health Council for the remainder of 2025.

LORAAS contracts for 2025 were accepted.

A resolution was made to allow the Delisle Rodeo and Outdoor Rink Association to be included in the Town insurance policy provided they reimburse the Town their respective apportioned costs each year.

A resolution was made to incorporate a \$5 paper bill fee for utility services starting in 2026, for those accounts which are not on e-billing.

Bylaw No 5-2025, being a bylaw to enter into a new amended agreement with the Fire Commission, was passed.







