
COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

- Council held a regular meeting on June 12th at 7pm.
- Western Municipal Consulting was appointed as the 2025 Development Appeals Board.
- The Town allowed a temporary street closure of 1st Street West from 1st Avenue to 3rd Avenue as well as half a block in either direction on 2nd Avenue for the 2025 Show and Shine on July 12th, 2025.
- The Council acknowledged and accepted the 2025 **Education Property Tax mill rates:**

Agricultural 1.07 Residential 4.27 Commercial/Industrial 6.37 Resource 7.49

- The 2024 year end audited financial statements were acknowledged and accepted.
- Bylaw 2-2025 was passed to establish a land lease with the Delisle Rodeo Committee.
- Bylaw 6-2025 was passed to implement a new Transfer Station supervisor contract.




