BYLAW NO. 11-2025

**A BYLAW TO CONTROL THE OPERATION OF ALL TERRAIN VEHICLES
WITHIN THE TOWN OF DELISLE**

The Council of the Town of Delisle in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

AUTHORITY

1. This Bylaw is enacted pursuant to Section 9(1) of the All Terrain Vehicles Act.

DEFINITIONS

2. In this Bylaw:
 - a. "All Terrain Vehicle" is defined in Section 2(1)(b) of The All Terrain Vehicles Act and does not include a golf cart, a snowmobile as defined in The Snowmobile Act, agricultural implements and machinery, or any other vehicle which is required to be registered pursuant to The Traffic Safety Act.
 - b. "Street" means any street or lane within the Town of Delisle.
 - c. "Untravelled portion of the street" refers to the furthest right-hand portion of the street, typically used for parking of vehicles.
 - d. "Town" refers to the Town of Delisle.

GENERAL

3. Pursuant to Section 9 of The All Terrain Vehicles Act:
 - a. It shall be unlawful to operate an All Terrain Vehicle between the hours of 11:00 P.M. and 7:00 A.M. in the Town.
 - b. No person shall operate an All Terrain Vehicle on the travelled portion of any street in Town except to cross a street when travelling from private property to the corporate limits of the Town.
 - c. All Terrain Vehicles may be operated on the untraveled portion of the street; other than provincial highways, within the Town, for the purpose of travelling directly from private owned property to the corporate limits of the Town and may return by the most direct route to the private property.
 - i. All Terrain Vehicles equipped with a snowblade may briefly travel on the untraveled portion of roadway for the purpose of clearing their driveway of snow or turning around to facilitate this purpose. Snow pushed in this manner must be deposited onto the owner's property and not onto local roadways per Section 18 of Bylaw 10-2021.
 - d. All Terrain Vehicles may not be operated on any Municipal Reserves, Parks, Buffer Strips, Walkways, cemetery land, private land that is not owned by the operator, or any other area that is ditched or designed to provide drainage and any Crown-owned land.
 - e. All Terrain Vehicles may not be operated on the following streets and roads other than for the purpose of directly crossing while traveling directly from private owned property to the corporate limits of the Town:
 - i. 1st Street West



- ii. Railway Avenue
 - iii. Elevator Road
- f. No person shall operate or permit any other person to operate an All Terrain Vehicle within Town:
- i. Unless the owner and every person who operates the All Terrain Vehicle has obtained liability insurance within the meaning of Division 3 of Part VIII of The Insurance Act for the use or operation of the All Terrain Vehicle in the amount of a minimum of \$200,000 per Section 4 of The All Terrain Vehicles Act Regulations.
 - ii. Unless they are over the age of 16 years old and hold a valid Saskatchewan driver's license
 - iii. Unless all occupants and/or riders are wearing helmets and eye protection as described in Sections 5 and 6 of The All Terrain Vehicles Act Regulations.
 - iv. For the purpose of attending a gas station to fill up the All Terrain Vehicle with gas or diesel.
 - v. At a speed in excess of 20 kilometers per hour (kph).
 - vi. With a passenger on the All Terrain Vehicle unless the All Terrain Vehicle was designed by the original manufacturer of the All Terrain Vehicle for the transportation of passengers
 - vii. With a passenger being towed behind the All Terrain Vehicle
 - viii. With an All Terrain Vehicle that creates excessive or unusual noise

ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES

4. Any person who contravenes this Bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable, upon summary conviction, to a fine of not less than \$200.00 in addition to any other penalties as set forth in the All Terrain Vehicles Act.
- a. Any Peace Officer, including the Town's Bylaw Enforcement Officer, is hereby authorized and empowered to remove, impound, and store any All Terrain Vehicle, without warrant, that does not comply to the regulations as set in this Bylaw
- i. Impound fees shall be \$150.00 plus any incidental costs associated with transport and storage of the involved All Terrain Vehicle.
 - ii. Impound fees shall be in addition to any fine as levied per this section.
5. The owner of an All Terrain Vehicle is liable for any contravention of any provision of this Bylaw in connection with the operation of the All Terrain Vehicle.


SEVERABILITY

6. This Bylaw shall not be construed to hold the Town of Delisle or its agents responsible or liable for any injury to persons or damage to property through the operation of an All Terrain Vehicle under this Bylaw, at all times the owner of the All Terrain Vehicle shall remain liable.

COMING INTO FORCE

7. Bylaw 8-96 is hereby repealed
8. This Bylaw shall come into force on the day of adoption by the Town of Delisle Council.






