COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

Council held a regular meeting on July 9th at 7pm during which the following items were addressed:

- Jatin Saini was appointed as the new Chief Administrative Officer with a starting date of July 27th, 2026.*
- Mark Dubkowski was appointed as Mentor.*
- Councillor Brunett was assigned as a secondary signing authority for the purpose of approving online payments.*
- Council agreed to apply for the Build Communities Strong Fund for funding assistance for the East Subdivision Phase 1 residential development project.*
- September 21st - 27th was proclaimed as Rail Safety Week.*
- Council directed Administration to send a letter to the Minister of Crown Investments Corporation, supporting a provincial ride-sharing framework.*
- Council supported the “Message from the Mayor” and authorized its publication.*
- Council agreed to support the High School’s request for a hockey academy and agreed to adjust non-prime ice rates to \$125 per hour in support of the request.*
- Council approved Zamboni repairs quoted by Fer Marc in the amount of \$11,492.27 (includes taxes).*
- Council agreed to the proposed playschool lease agreement for use of the Hall as presented and supported their request for gratuitous use of the hall for their annual Christmas concert.*
- Council excluded from the List of Lands in arrears those lands with tax arrears not exceeding ½ of the previous year’s levy.*
- Council approved the List of Lands in Arrears and directed that the list should be advertised.*
- Council approved the new arena booking and cancellation policy, as presented, and authorized a 5% discount for local user groups during the period of time the schedule is locked down between October 15th and February 1st.*
