**COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS**

**Council held a regular meeting on June 11th at 7pm during which the following items were addressed:**

- Council awarded the 2026 High School Grad Bursary to Nikia Schlosser upon proof of enrolment into post secondary schooling
- Council approved new cemetery fees (all exclude GST):
  - Standard Plot = \$500
  - Cremation Plot = \$150
  - Columbarium Niche = \$1700
- Council approved new proposed tax abatement incentives for new builds and upgrades and directed administration to prepare the necessary bylaw.
- Council directed administration to redraft lease agreements for all organizations utilizing town assets to require them to provide annual proof of insurance coverage, including general liability up to \$2,000,000 as well as confirmation that the Town of Delisle has been listed as an additional insured.
- Council agreed to initiate fees for the Delisle Playschool's use of the hall at a rate of \$4 per child for the months that the school is in session and also agreed to provide the hall to the Delisle Playschool for the annual Christmas concert, gratuitously.
- Council agreed to refund Delisle Minor Baseball \$40 for their use of the concession for a recent tournament.
- Council agreed to a temporary road closure on 1<sup>st</sup> Street West on July 11<sup>th</sup>, 2026 for the annual Show and Shine.
- Council supported a proposed sub-contractor agreement for Damon Werrell to continue duties as Chief Administrative Officer until a replacement is in place.
