Delisle Community RCMP Detachment is located at 201-1st St. West in the same building as the Town Office and Wheatland Library. Delisle Detachment is amalgamated with Martensville, Radisson and Warman with a total complement of 31 sworn officers and 6 civilian support staff. The Detachment provides 24-hour policing coverage and encompasses much of the area surrounding Saskatoon to the north and west. This includes the RMs of Corman Park, Vanscoy, Montrose, Great Bend, Mayfield and all the cities and towns within those boundaries, except for the Town of Dalmeny, which has its own police service. RCMP encourages the public to contact them whenever there are policing issues; e.g. traffic violations, theft, vandalism, etc. If citizens do not contact the RCMP, the RCMP are not aware of the problem and are therefore unable to allocate manpower to the problem or the area.

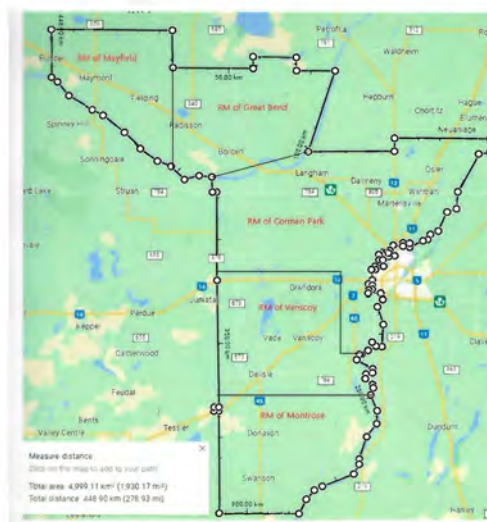
Criminal record checks for employment or volunteer purposes are available. If you live in the Asquith, Delisle, Grandora, Pike Lake, or Vanscoy area you must apply for the record check at Delisle. You may go to Martensville or Warman office if you are unable to attend the Delisle office during their open hours. However, be aware that there is a \$40 fee charged at both locations for all criminal record checks and vulnerable sector checks for employment purposes. There is a ONE WEEK WAIT FOR RESULTS.

For volunteer positions at ALL LOCATIONS, you must present a letter from the organization you are volunteering with clearly explaining how a position's duties meet the criteria for a Vulnerable Sector Check. Each letter is specific to the position and is used for that one application only. It can't be a generic form letter or be used for different positions. The letter should also state the person will not be paid for services. **YOU CANNOT HAVE IT DONE IN SASKATOON!!!** You must appear in person with two pieces of valid government issued identification (e.g.; driver's license, health card, passport). Please make sure to apply for your record check well in advance of when you need it as delays do exist.

Delisle office hours are: Tuesdays 8:30 am- 12:30 pm and 1:30 to 5:00 p.m.; Wednesdays 8:30 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. Thursdays 8:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. and 1:30 to 5:00 p.m. **Please call (306)493-3240 to ensure the office is open as unscheduled closures do occur on occasion.**

Non-emergency calls can be made to **310-7267**. **Emergencies** should be communicated through **911**.

Delisle Elementary School is a Kindergarten to Grade 6 school with average student enrollments between 200-215 students. Our attendance area includes the community of Delisle and surrounding areas, with students from Pike Lake School coming to DES starting in Grade 5.

At DES, we are focused on strengthening literacy and numeracy with annual school goal on reading, writing, and math skills across all grade levels. We strive to put Reconciliation into action with different presentations, learning experiences, and activities that honour Indigenous perspectives, cultures, and histories.

We offer a wide range of engaging learning experiences, like author visits, presentations, field trips, and community partnerships. We also value hands-on, real-world learning, whether it is in our school garden or out in the community with skating, curling, biking, snowshoeing, or cross-country skiing. Students can also get involved in extracurricular activities like clubs, leadership opportunities, cross-country running, and new this spring, the 'Jays Care' introduction to baseball program.

DES has an active and supportive School Community Council (SCC) which hosts monthly hybrid meetings (in-person and online for flexibility) that works hard to strengthen connections between families, school, and the community. They plan events, workshops, and family activities like our annual Family Fun Night in September, a spring Family Bingo, as well as other workshops and guest speakers.

We have a large parent resource section in the library and welcome the expertise that families and community members bring to our students as volunteers in a number of areas including agriculture, reading, math, fine arts and more.

FOOTBALL PROGRAM

Open to male and females, grades 9 to 12 ,with league play and provincial playoffs, as well as a junior skill development tournament.

JUNIOR VOLLEYBALL/BASKETBALL

Developmental programs for male and females with exhibition games and practices.

SENIOR VOLLEYBALL

Male and Female teams, competing against schools through tournament play and provincial playoffs.

SENIOR BASKETBALL

Male and Female teams, competing against schools through tournament play and provincial playoffs.

TRACK & FIELD

Sprints and distance runs include hurdles, 100m, 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, and 3000m.

Field events include shot put, javelin, discus, long jump, triple jump, and high jump. Students compete according to age category, with those over 15 years able to compete at provincials.

JUNIOR/ SENIOR BADMINTON

Students have the opportunity to take part in singles, doubles and mixed teams.

As well, we appreciate the parents and community members who volunteer for the SCC (School Community Council). The group meets at most once per month, and we are always looking for new members.

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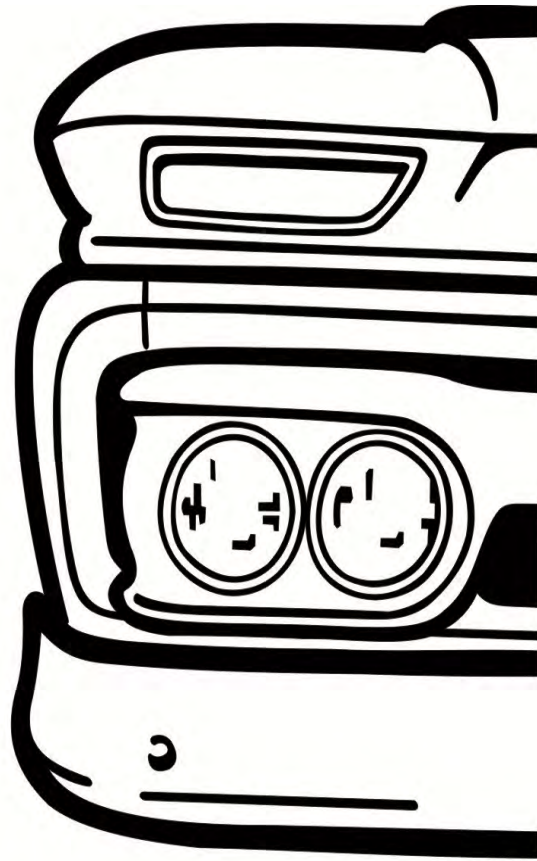
