1. Delisle Seniors

- a. New sign is up, looks great. Done by Cathy McMillan.
- b. Will be hosting a bingo – February 21, 2026

- f. There is a new cleaner who also does snow removal for the clinic.
- g. Been in contact with Life Labs due to complaints about there being no coverage when the Delisle tech is off. They have said they will have coverage when she is away.

4. Elementary School

- a. Enrollment is up by 5 students as of the new year.
- b. A school wide meal was held in December, weather unfortunately cancelled the family engagement night.
- c. Ski Trip is coming up on February 11, 2026.
- d. Skating is held on Fridays at the Rink
