COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

Council held a regular meeting on August 13th at 7pm during which the following items were addressed:

Fall Fest: Council approved the requested street closure for Fall Fest on September 12, 2026, and approved \$1,500 in Town sponsorship for the community Movie Night.

Railway Avenue Lighting: Council directed Administration to apply to SaskPower for funding for lighting improvements along Railway Avenue at the entrance into Town.

Off-Leash Dog Park: Council did not approve the proposed dog park location on 3rd Street West but invited the proponents to bring forward an alternative location for Council's consideration.

Student-Made Christmas Decorations: Council approved a \$5,000 contribution to the Delisle Composite High School IA Program in recognition of the Christmas light decorations produced by students for the Town.

Arena Booking Policy: Council approved the Arena Booking and Cancellation Policy, including a 5% discount for local organizations during the October 15 to February 1 commitment period.

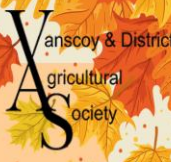
